



Tennessee Secondary School Athletic Association Student Advisory Committee Application

The TSSAA Student Advisory Committee consists of a diverse group of students and student-athletes from member schools throughout the state. This team will act as ambassadors for their peers and the TSSAA while gaining insights into the sports industry through various committee activities. The committee will ensure that student perspectives are represented in TSSAA governance, focusing on key areas such as current issues affecting student-athletes, feedback on rules and regulations, contributions to TSSAA special initiatives, and the promotion of a positive image of student-athletes.

Application Process/ Requirements for the 2025-2026 Committee

- All rising Juniors and Seniors are eligible to be members of the committee.
- Be a student-athlete participating in at least **ONE** TSSAA sanctioned sport.
- Applications will be open from March 1st, 2026 until March 27th, 2026. The selection of committee members will be finalized by May 1st, 2026. · Completed applications will need to be submitted no later than March 27th by the end of the day. **No late applications will be accepted. Applications submitted through email will not be accepted! All applications are submitted online through a website this year. The link will be open for submissions March 1st.**
- Parent approval and support
- A 30-second video (minimum) introduction regarding the applicant **IS REQUIRED. Applications without a video submission will not be reviewed.**

Students nominated for the TSSAA Student Advisory Committee must:

- Be a rising junior or senior
- Have a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or greater. (GPA will be from the fall semester)
- Demonstrate leadership within school
- Strong character and commitment to sportsmanship and integrity
- (2) recommendation letters from an acceptable individual (Principal, Athletic Director, Coach, and/or Teacher)

The following list includes a tentative outline of duties of a TSAC member. Before applying, please make sure that you would be able to execute these responsibilities. These may evolve depending on what each member deems doable and manageable within their respective regions. We understand that individual circumstances can vary significantly, and it is essential that we remain flexible in our expectations.

- Attend both fall and spring meetings (via zoom if unable to attend in-person)
- Be the voice of students from their respective regions within the TSSAA governance structure, and offer input and suggestions on current issues facing students
- Give input regarding rules and regulations
- Give input and actively participate in the development of TSSAA special initiatives and campaigns
 - o Officials Appreciation, RefReps, Sports Medicine Appreciation, Mental Health, Bullying, Drinking & Driving
- Promote a positive image of student participation in interscholastic competition
- **Volunteer at ONE TSSAA championship event**
