

TSSAA Governance / Structure

Protocol for Proposals to TSSAA

Proposals from schools fall under the jurisdiction of one of the following groups.

TSSAA Legislative Council

- TSSAA Bylaws and Sports Calendars
- Deadline for submitting proposals October 15th
- Proposals are then voted on by member schools at TSSAA Regional Meetings
- The vote is shared with the Legislative Council at their December meeting. They then vote yes or
- Approved proposals generally go into effect the following school year

TSSAA Board of Control

- TSSAA Sports Regulations, tournament locations, classification
- The Board meets five times a year
- Proposals must be submitted by the principal or athletic director of a member school to the TSSAA Executive Director, who then decides whether or not to place it on the agenda

NFHS Rules Committees

- Proposals to change NFHS Rules must be submitted to TSSAA for consideration
- NFHS Rules Committees can only accept proposals submitted by the TSSAA state office
- TSSAA state office has the authority to decide if the proposal is to be submitted for consideration
- Proposals should site the original rule to be changed, the rationale for the change, and the new rule language
- The TSSAA Bylaws do not permit any deviation from NFHS Rules for competition.

TSSAA Staff

Some proposals deal directly with the administration of events and are ultimately decided by TSSAA staff. Examples of proposals such as this are tournament schedule, location of team benches at state duals, credentials and gate procedures. If there is disagreement with TSSAA staff, coaches may ask their school's administration to appeal to the TSSAA Board of Control.

Board approved ticket prices for state championship events:

Where TSSAA has control of parking, eliminate all parking fees and raise ticket prices. High school -

- Spectator Tickets: \$13 of GoFan/\$15 Cash per person per day
- At collegiate, professional, and multi-purpose arenas or venues: Spectator Tickets: \$15 on GoFan/\$20 Cash per person per day
- No parking charge, except in metropolitan areas where we do not control lots. TSSAA will develop revenue sharing options for high school host sites that have previously received \$5 per car.

Middle school -

- Spectator Tickets: \$10 on GoFan/\$12 Cash per person per day
- No parking charge. TSSAA will develop revenue sharing options for middle and high school host sites that have previously received \$5 per car.

Administrators -

TSSAA will be utilizing GoFan for your Administrator's Passes this year.


