



Suspension of Play and Evacuation Procedure

2025 TSSAA State Boys Golf Championship – Sevierville Golf Course – River Course

Suspension of Play Due to Dangerous Situation (as stated on TSSAA Rules of Play Card):

Optional Condition as prescribed in Appendix I is in effect. All practice areas are closed during suspension for a dangerous situation until the Committee has declared them open. Players who practice on closed practice areas will be asked to cease doing so.

NOTE: A suspension for a dangerous situation will be signaled by one prolonged air horn note. All other types of suspension will be signaled by three consecutive air horn notes, repeated. Resumption of play will be signaled by two short air horn notes, repeated.

Evacuation Procedure:

When play is suspended by the Committee for a dangerous situation, all contestants, spectators, and volunteers are encouraged to evacuate the golf course as quickly and safely as possible. If the players in a group are between the play of two holes, they must not resume play until the Committee has ordered a resumption of play. If they are in the process of playing a hole, they must discontinue play immediately and not resume until the Committee has ordered a resumption of play.

Listed below is a specific guide listing where you should proceed if play were to be suspended for a dangerous situation.

Evacuation Cart Locations:

Priority for Evacuation: 1st – players, 2nd – coaches, 3rd – spectators

Hole #2 green – 2 carts

Hole #3 tee – 2 carts

Hole #4 Green – 2 carts

Hole #6 green & #10 tee – 4 carts

Hole #8 tee – 2 carts

Hole #12 green – 2 carts

Between #11 & #14 – 2 carts

Hole #14 green – 2 carts

Hole #15 tee & Hole #10 – 3 carts
