16. RePublic High School requests cooperative agreement in football

The RePublic High School administration is requesting that they be able to seek a cooperative agreement with another school this year. The state office was notified that they are discontinuing their football program.

The Board must also consider if the school will be allowed to participate in the basketball post-season tournament series after dropping their football program.

17. RePublic High School appeals probation

The RePublic High School administration is requesting to appeal the school's probationary status for two years. The school's boys' basketball program is on restrictive probation and the school's total athletic program is on probation through January 23, 2022, due to a brawl that occurred during the boys' basketball contest against Hume-Fogg Academic Magnet High School on January 10, 2020. The school's boys' basketball program was already on probation from a previous situation when this incident occurred. The administration will be present to make their appeal.

18. Polk Innovative Learning Academy requests TSSAA membership

Polk Innovative Learning Academy is requesting membership in TSSAA. This is a public virtual school under the Polk County Board of Education. They currently have 50 students in grades K-11. If approved, they plan to form a cooperative agreement with Polk County High School. They do not plan to offer any sports sanctioned by TSSAA.
